On February 21, 1921, seven courageous collegiates chartered Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, Inc., Kappa Chapter – making it the first Black-greek lettered organization chartered west of the Rocky Mountains, and the first Black-greek lettered organization on UC Berkeley's campus. Their commitment to sisterhood, scholarship and service laid the foundation for Kappa Chapter sorors to become leaders on Cal's campus, within their professions, and in their communities.
